TWO BILLBOARDS BEARING THE PHOTO of 17-year-old Lauren Mulkey were raised this week in Salt Lake City in hopes of causing drivers to think twice about using their cell phones while driving. Mulkey was killed March 18 when a driver, apparently talking on his cell phone, hit her sport utility vehicle in the intersection of 1300 East and 2100 South. Her mother, Linda Mulkey, said the billboard company contributed the space. The billboards are on 1300 East near East High School, and on 3300 South between State and Main streets.
